




Before you begin

Make sure that you have access to a Business Manager account or create one

Check that you're an admin on the Business Manager account that you'd like to use

Log in to Facebook Business > Select Business

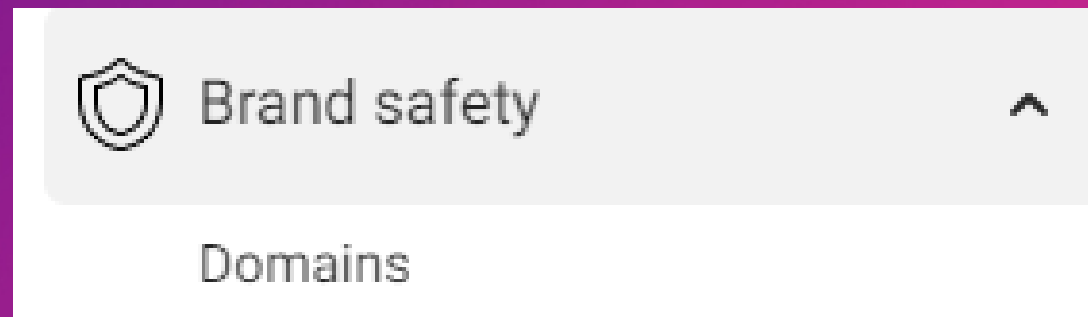

Add a meta-tag
Verify this domain by copying and pasting the provided meta-tag code into the `<head>` ... `<head>` section of your website's home page HTML code.

Copy to clipboard tag:
`<meta name="facebook-domain-verification" content="jv8rnbxsc8k8hpcn75qbm0gtk3klsu" />`

2. Paste the meta-tag into the `<head>` ... `<head>` section of the website's home page HTML source, and publish the page.
Note: Verification will fail if the meta-tag code is outside the `<head>` section or in a section loaded dynamically by JavaScript.

3. After you've published the home page, confirm that the meta-tag is visible by visiting <http://example.com/> and viewing the HTML source.

4. Click **Verify domain**.
Note: It may take up to 72 hours for Facebook to find the meta-tag code. If the domain status is still not verified, you'll need to click **Verify domain** again or confirm the meta-tag is listed in the scrape results in the [Sharing Debugger Tool](#).
